RESEARCH TOPICS / EXPERIENCES	My research focuses on the relationship between contemporary Italian literature and new media in the global age. I dealt with the Gomorra Brand and in particular the transmedia universe that was built around Saviano's work (TV series, films, video games, comix etc.). If on the one hand my research investigates the branding of culture and the transmedia storytelling, on the other hand it focuses on the analysis of the representation of Italy in contemporary media culture. This attention then extends more generally to communication and enhancement of cultural heritage, and particularly to positive/negative stereotypes and the media representation of places: e.g., the Sicilian Baroque of the Montalbano series, the Naples of Saviano and Ferrante, the Sicily of Sciascia. Such places are a powerful vehicle for the image of Italy, they become a destination for tourists and contribute to the creation of the Brand Italy (food, lifestyle, illustrious cultural tradition, beauty of the landscape and even criminality, familism, subculture). Ultimately, assuming the perspectives of cultural studies and microhistory, the aim of my research is focused on storytelling of cultural memory: digital techniques are aimed at the interpretation and public dissemination of this object of research, particularly on the side of reception studies. Cultural heritage, promoted and represented by transmedia storytelling, is appropriated by users, and gives rise to user-generated content (e.g., web series, video games, YouTube parodies, memes, online reviews, social network discussion groups). The research is therefore focused on activity of re-appropriation of cultural content by users as a key factor in the inclusive, grassroots promotion of cultural heritage, and to the transnational imaginary of the global age. I have participated as a speaker at 32 international conferences and 22 national conferences organized by university around the world.
